TENTH LINE WEST/TRELAWNY CIRCLE - ROAD RESURFACING PROGRAM ~ WARD 10

The City of Mississauga will begin to repave certain laneways off of Tenth Line West, Trelawny Circle and Bishop Strachan Court in the next two weeks (see map on back for exact locations). The work will include replacing asphalt on the road and repairs to curbs and sidewalks. The project is scheduled to be completed in six to eight weeks (weather permitting). The contract was awarded to **Associated Paving and Materials Ltd.** We are confident that they will complete the project competently and in a timely manner.

Construction Information:

- Construction will take place in stages and there may be delays between each stage.
- If your driveway curb is replaced, a part of the driveway and grass behind curb will also be replaced.
- The City guarantees all workmanship and materials for one year after completion of the construction activity.

Residents Please Note:

- Access to your driveway will be interrupted for two to three days.
- Residents must remove fixtures such as sprinkler heads and sprinkler systems prior to construction. The City will not be responsible for any damages to fixtures which were installed on City property.
- Please water the sod in front of your property if it has been replaced to ensure proper growth.
- Avoid contact with hot asphalt or any construction material at all times.

Parking Information:

- Residents can park on the following streets if their driveway is not accessible due to construction: Tenth Line West, Trelawny Circle, Bishop Strachan Court and Mockingbird Lanes.
- The City's Parking Enforcement Officers will be advised not to issue tickets on the streets mentioned above for 'Parking in Excess of Three Hours' while your driveway is not accessible.
- Please be aware that Parking Tickets will still be issued for violations such as: parking against the traffic flow, parking too close to a corner, parking in front of a fire hydrant or in a signed fire route, or blocking a neighbour's driveway.

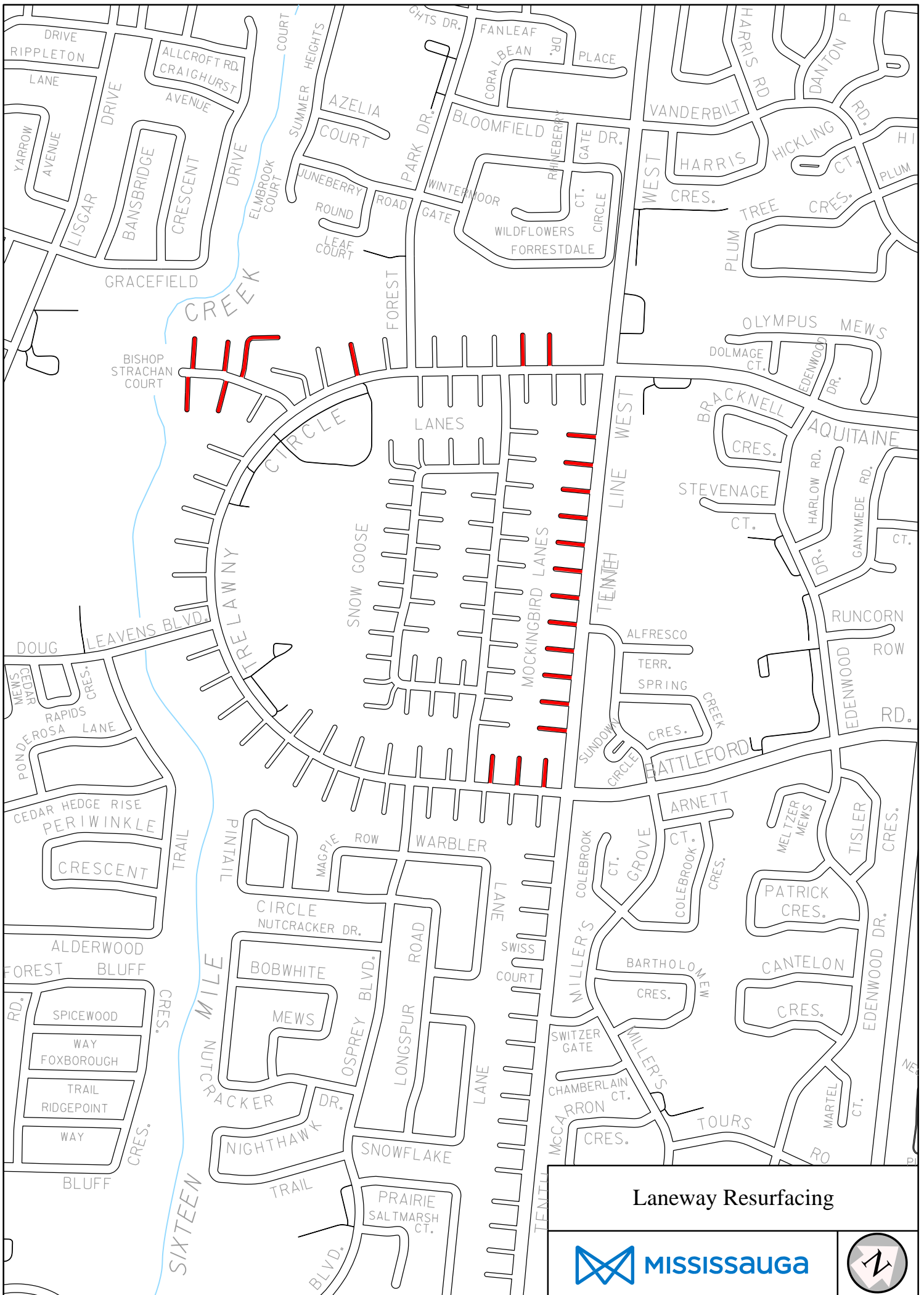
